Patmos is one of northernmost islands in the Dodecanese and one of the smallest, most charming and most spiritual. It has an atmosphere of sacred grandeur. Patmos is most famous for being where the Book of Revelations was written, and where the vision to John the Baptist that it refers to is supposedly located. When John was banished by Rome to Patmos near the end of his life, he was the last remaining of the 12 Disciples. You can visit St John's Monastery and the Holy Grotto of the Apocalypse, both of which have drawn pilgrims for centuries.


Vibrant and colourful, Kusadasi in Turkey is
