Treasures of the Danube

From the Black Forest to the shores of Black Sea, delight in a leisurely cruise over one of the world's greatest Rivers and experience some of Europe's most splendid cities on your way along the romantic Danube.

Day 1: MUNICH – PASSAU (Germany)

Arrival in Munich, the capital of Bavaria. Reception at the airport followed by guided tour of Munich. After the city tour, bus transfer to Passau and embarkation on board of M/S AROSA. At 10 pm, start of navigation to Linz.

Day 2: LINZ (Austria)

Arrive in the early morning (around 6 am) at Linz. Time at leisure in Linz or join an optional excursion: *Optional guided tour of Linz (half day): Back to the ship for lunch on board. Or Optional excursion "Art Cities of Bohemia" (full day with lunch): Morning departure to the Czech Republic. Guided city tour of Ceske Budejovice, jewel of the Renaissance. Or Optional tour in Salzburg (full day with lunch): Departure to Salzburg, the city of music. Visit the city and stroll in the streets of the city centre.*

Day 3: MELK (Austria)

After breakfast, free time or *Optional excursion to the Abbey of Melk and Dürnstein (half day): Enjoy a guided tour of Melk's Benedictine Abbey. From there, continuation to Dürnstein, right in the heart of the picturesque Wachau wine-growing region, to enjoy a wine tasting. Lunch on board. Navigation during the afternoon through the exceptional landscapes of the Wachau.*

Day 4: VIENNA (Austria)

After breakfast, guided city tour exploring the wonders of Vienna. Panoramic tour with the lavish Hofburg Palace,

Vienna Opera, the famous Ringstrasse and spectacular St Stephen's Cathedral (from outside). Lunch on board. Afternoon free or *Optional tour to Schönbrunn (half day), the "Viennese Versailles". Optional Music concert: Enjoy an optional concert in celebration of the city's unique musical heritage.*

Day 5: BRATISLAVA (Slovakia)

Arrive around 7 am in Bratislava, capital of Slovakia. After breakfast, guided walking tour of the city. After the tour, free time or *Optional tour to Červený Kameň castle: Červený Kamen is considered the most beautiful castle in the Western Carpathian, one of the best preserved in Slovakia.*

Day 6: BUDAPEST (Hungary)

In the morning, half day guided tour of the city. Straddling the banks of the Danube, with no less than seven bridges connecting Buda on the East bank to Pest on the West. Afternoon free time or join an optional excursion: *Optional Excursion "Uncommon Budapest" (half day): The tour starts with the visit of the Great Market Hall, the largest indoor market in Budapest. It was designed and built by*

Samu Pecz in 1896. Or Optional afternoon at the Széchenyi baths (half day): Departure by bus for an afternoon of relaxation at Széchenyi Baths. Dinner on board.

Day 7: MOHACS (Hungary) - VUKOVAR (Croatia)

Arrival in Mohacs in the morning. Free time on board with lunch or disembark to participate to *optional excursion Visages of Slavonia (full day with lunch).* In the morning, M/S Arosa continues the sailing until Vukovar where she arrives at the end of the afternoon. Dinner on board. Departure to Belgrade in the evening.

Day 8: BELGRADE (Serbia)

In the morning, guided tour of Belgrade, capital of Serbia. In the afternoon, time at leisure or take the *Optional Topola excursion (half day): visit of the tiny city of Topola, located south which saw the outbreak of the revolt against the*

Designed both on a concept of luxury and optimal comfort, the whole setting remains refined while based on keeping a minimalist and full of simplicity style. Public areas are highlighted, the 1.700 m² Sun Deck with a large swimming pool. On the Upper Deck are located all common areas with restaurant that can be partially privatized. A large panoramic bar is at the front of the ship whereas a second one is available near the restaurant main entrance. There are an outdoor pool on the sun deck, shuffleboard and a putting green. The SPA-ROSA wellness facilities include a sauna and a hammam.

LARGE AND VERY COMFORTABLE CABINS

Cabins are spread over three decks (Main, Upper, Panorama Deck). They are all outside and finely decorated in a warm, intimate and modern style. All cabins have twin beds that can be made up as a double with high quality bedding under a canopy. They all have storable spaces, a TV. Bathrooms are equipped with a large shower, toilets, sink and hair dryer. Air-conditioning and climate control are individually adjustable.



Turks under the leadership of Karadjodje. Dinner on board or Optional dinner at Skadarija : Skadarija is a vintage street and generally considered the main Bohemian quarter and styled as the Belgrade Montmartre.

Day 9: SAILING THROUGH THE IRON GATES GORGE (Serbia)

A day of spectacular scenery awaits you as your ship sails along the magnificent Danube, passing memorable such as the coloured Serbian fortresses of Golubac and Smederevo, as well as Trajan's Tablet, a remarkable rock side tablet carved by the Romans to commemorate their crossing of the Danube. Today's highpoint is when the ship passes through the dramatic Iron Gates Gorge, a narrow steep-sided ravine, which forms a natural border between Serbia & Romania.

Day 10: ORJAHOVO (Bulgaria)

Early morning, ship docks in the small port of Orjahoivo on the Bulgarian Bank of the Danube. Free exploration of the

city and lunch on board or Full day optional excursion to Sofia (lunch included): Visit of the city, the main arteries of the centre, the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and the Archaeological Museum.

Day 11: ROUSSE (Bulgaria)

After breakfast, discovery of Rousse on your own with lunch on board or Optional excursion to Veliko Tirmovo (lunch included): You will enjoy this full day excursion to admire Bulgaria's ancient capital. Captain's Dinner on board.

Day 12: OLTENITA - BUCHAREST (Romania)

Arrival around 6 am. Breakfast on board. Disembark the ship at Oltenita, and then transfer to Romania's lively capital; Bucharest. The city is home to exquisite churches, bustling cafés and some magnificent architecture from the colossal, Soviet-style, Parliament Palace to the classical and stately Royal Palace (outside views). Transfer to the airport for your return flight.





Legendary Mekong

The Mekong is a legend, a universe where water is the engine of life. A sort of a link between China, Laos, Cambodia and Vietnam. From Saigon to the Temples of Angkor, our Mekong cruises will gradually introduce you to this world so far away and so close at the same time.

Day 1: HO CHI MINH CITY (SAIGON) - MY THO

(Lunch & Dinner on board)

Transfer from Saigon to My Tho in the morning. The transfer includes a stop at the Cholon Market and visit to a lacquer factory. Arrival in My Tho and welcome on board the R/V MEKONG PRESTIGE II. Welcome Dinner on board & traditional Music Show.

Day 2: CAI BE - SA DEC

(All meals on board)

Arrival at Cai Be in the morning. After breakfast we take a morning junk trip around Cai Be to visit a floating market

and go ashore to see the French Gothic Cathedral. Take a stroll along the river bank, visit a local manufacturer producing rice paper and coconut sweets. Return to the ship for lunch. Cruise past Vinh Long Province to arrive at Sa Dec for an afternoon walk. Visit a Cao daist Temple and stroll through the colorful local market. Night navigation through the Delta.

Day 3: TAN CHAU, border crossing

(All meals on board)

Arrival at Tan Chau in the morning. After breakfast, transfer on small boats to visit a fishing farm. We go ashore to visit a local workshop producing woven mats, and take a short walk in the village to visit a silk weaving workshop. Depart for the Cambodian border.

Day 4: PHNOM PENH

(All meals on board)

Arrival in Phnom Penh in the morning. Visit the Royal Palace and the Silver Pagoda. The National Museum is another highlight, with outstanding displays of Khmer crafts. Lunch on board. Afternoon excursion to the former High School "S21", followed by a visit to Wat Phnom after which the city was named. Traditional Khmer Apsara Dancing Show on board.

Day 5: KOH CHONG - PHNOM PENH

(All meals on board)

Early morning sailing from Phnom Penh to Koh Chong. Visit this silk weaving village for a morning walk at leisure and a visit to the local workshop. The excursion also includes a visit to a Pagoda and a meeting in a primary school to chat with pupils.

Day 6: OUDONG - KAMPONG TRALACH

(All meals on board)

Morning journey upriver heading towards Oudong. Arrival at Oudong in the early afternoon. We see the Vipassana Dhura Pagoda, a place of meditation for Buddhist Monks. After the visit buses depart for Kampong Tralach to visit the very charming Vihara of the Wat Kampong Leu Pagoda dating back to the last century to see the beautiful wall paintings. Return to the ship by ox-drawn carriage.

R/V MEKONG PRESTIGE II



Built in the shipyards of SSIC (Saigon Ship Industry Company), the R/V Mekong Prestige II is the second in a series of top of the range river cruise ships, specially designed to sail on the Mekong River between Vietnam and Cambodia. The 32 cabins are all outside and spread over two Decks, the Main & Upper Decks. Surface area goes from 20 m² to 27 m². They are all equipped with French private balconies, large windows and sliding glass doors.

The Sun Deck covers the entire surface of the top Deck and commands a splendid view of the River. The Sun Deck is equipped with deckchairs and a whirlpool. The indoor area has 2 Massage Salons, an indoor lounge bar and a Fitness Room.



* IMPORTANT NOTICE

In case of low waters, it may happen that navigation on the Tonle Sap shall be impossible. Should that occurs; a fast boat will assure the link to the other bank of the lake where embarkation on the R/V Indochine will be taking place.

All the aforementioned cruise schedule and itinerary timing are indicative and are therefore subject to modifications.



Day 7: KAMPONG CHHNANG

(All meals on board)

Morning sailing on the Tonle Sap River. Arrive at Kampong Chhnang. Then board local boats to visit the authentic floating village. We go ashore to stroll through the scenic market. Lunch & Dinner on board.

Day 8: TONLE LAKE - SIEM REAP

(Breakfast on board)

We cross the lake early in the morning* (Please note that when there is low water, the transfer to Siem Reap will be made by bus or speed boat). Disembarkation after breakfast and transfer to hotel in Siem Reap.

EXTENSION TOURS BEFORE OR AFTER YOUR CRUISE:

HO CHI MINH CITY:

One night/2 days full board, including guided city tour and overnight at **SOFITEL Plaza** (5 stars).

SIEM REAP - ANGKOR:

2 nights/3 days at **Sokha Hotel**. Full guided exploration of Angkor Temples, including full board and transfer arrangements.



Burmese Odyssey

Journey along the Irrawaddy. Burma has never stopped fascinating Western travellers whom all testified of their amazement in exploring the fabulous city of Bagan or the glittering Swedagon Pagoda. We offer you to discover all these treasures, navigating on the mythical Irrawaddy River on board of the charming R/V Paukan.

Day 1: OVERSEAS FLIGHT TO BURMA

Day 2: YANGON (RANGOON)

Morning arrival in Rangoon. In the afternoon, sightseeing tour of Yangon also known as Rangoon. Amongst many wonders, visit of the Sule Pagoda and St Mary Cathedral. Cross the colonial district where the buildings have retained their ancient charm. By late afternoon, you walk up to the hill where Shwedagon Pagoda, the city's emblem, overlooks the entire city. Dinner in a restaurant and overnight at the hotel.

Day 3: YANGON

After crossing the Burmese countryside, arrive in the small town of Syriam. The avenues of the Than Lyn and Kyauk Tan market reflect the traditions of their people. The visit continues with Ye-Le Pagoda, built around the third century BCE. Then a must stop at the Scott Market, both worthy for its architecture and its craft shops. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 4: YANGON - MANDALAY - MINGUN (start of the cruise)

After breakfast, transfer to the airport and flight to Mandalay. You embark the R/V Paukan in late morning. The ship starts its navigation on the Irrawaddy River heading for

the village of Mingun, where you visit the unfinished Pagoda dating back to the Burmese Kingdom. Dinner & overnight on board.

Day 5: MANDALAY - AMARAPURA

Morning exploration of Mandalay, which abounds with ancient palaces and numerous religious sites. Start with the Mahamuni Pagoda, one of the most revered shrines of the country. After the onboard lunch, excursion to Amarapura, the penultimate Burmese Royal capital (1783). Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 6: SAGAING - AVA

Start this day by the discovery of Sagaing, historic centre of Burmese Buddhism. In the afternoon, visit of the ancient city of Ava, capital of the Burmese kingdom from 1364 to 1841. Explore the ruins by horse cart visiting the beautiful 200 years old Bagaya Kyaung Teak Monastery, the Nanmyin Watchtower (27m. high) and the Me Nu Ok Kyaung monastery. Traditional dance show by local performers on board.

Day 7: MONYWA

Full day exploration of Monywa. Departure by bus to reach the caves of Hpo Win Daung. One can also admire beautiful murals of that period. Then back to Monywa for Lunch at the restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the pagoda Sambuddhai Kat Kyaw.

Day 8: YANDABO - SHWE PYI THAR

Stop in the early morning at Yandabo. Explore the village stopping to some pot-making workshops to learn their unique production technique and then visit the school and the monastery. Lunch on board. In the afternoon, the ship will moor at Shwe Pyi Thar Village for a walk to discover local activities.

Day 9: BAGAN

Spend the entire day discovering the prestigious Bagan. The ancient Kingdom's capital ranks among the most significant religious site in the world. You visit a selection of the 2.000 listed pagodas and temples.

R/V PAUKAN



R/V Paukan was built in 2007 at the Yangon Shipyards. Paukan is the ancient name of Bagan, the old city of two thousand temples on the bank of the Irrawaddy River. The R/V Paukan has four Decks: Lower, Main, Upper & Sun Deck. The Sun/Top Deck is endowed with Air conditioned Saloon Bar, an Outdoor Bar, Al-Fresco Lounge and a Wheel House. It has also a stage for cultural performances. Meals in the dining room on the main deck will include both Eastern and Western cuisine, and dinner menus of delicious dishes. Vegetarian meals can be prepared when informed in advance. The timber-walled cabins are furnished with colonial style cupboards, dresser and doors while the ceiling is traditional Myanmar. The single or double beds are proper and comfortable ones and not mere bunks beds, enough room for 55 passengers who will be looked after by a 30-member crew.



Day 10: MOUNT POPA

Full day excursion to Mount Popa, an extinct volcano located 65 km South East of Bagan.. The popularity of Mt. Popa today lies in the interest of religious and mystical beliefs of the great family of the "Nats". Climb the Taungkalat to see the panoramic view of the whole area.

Day 11: BAGAN (End of the cruise) - YANGON

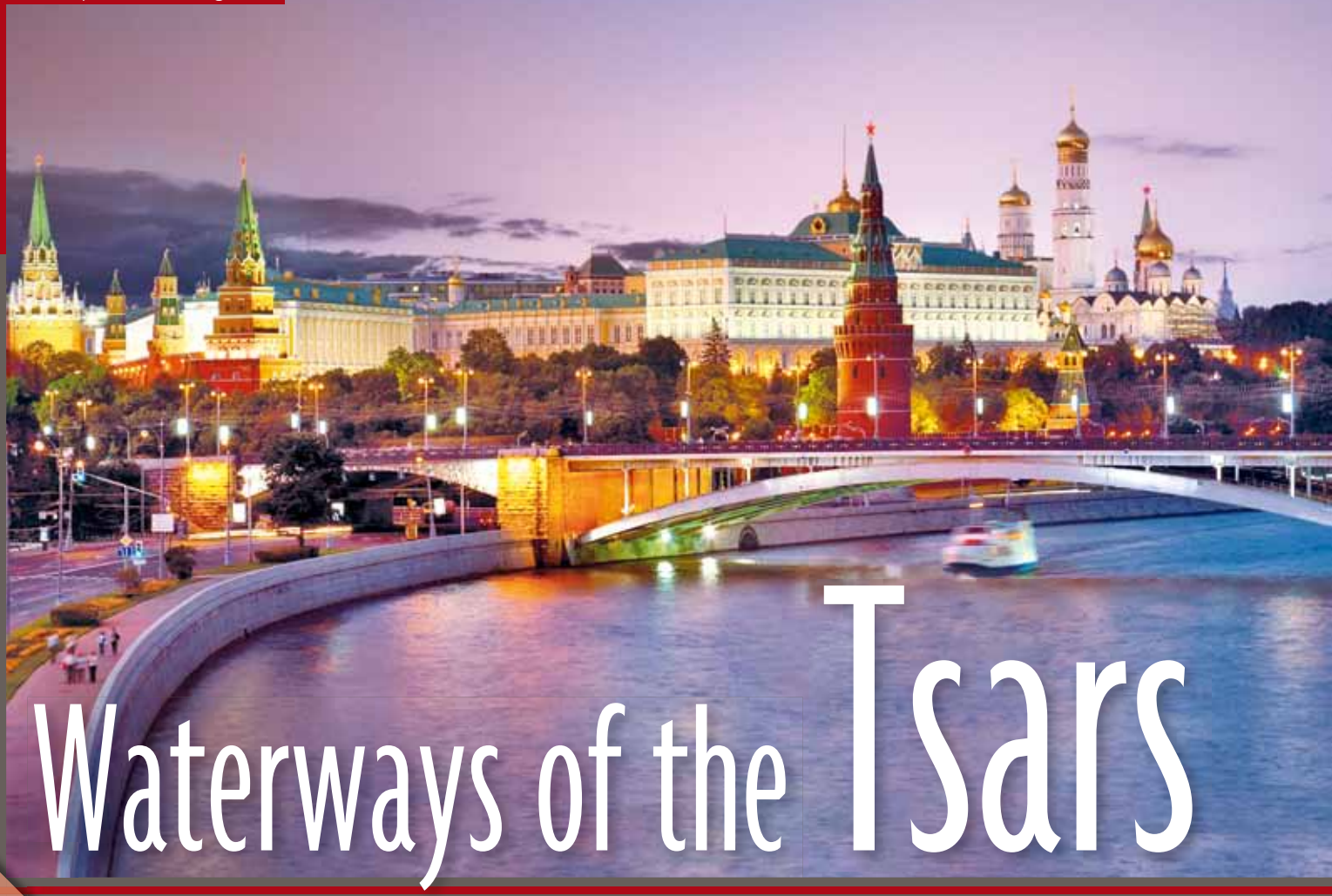
After breakfast, disembark and transfer to the airport for the flight to Yangon.

This extraordinary journey that connects the two capitals of Russia is the ideal way to explore Russia and its present and past architectural jewels.

Day 1: MOSCOW

Arrive in Moscow and transfer to the "Maritime Vokzal". Dinner & overnight on board.

Day 2: MOSCOW - CITY TOUR

After breakfast, morning orientation tour to all the famous sights to give you a first taste of Russia's capital. Afternoon at leisure or optional excursion. Breakfast & Dinner on board. Lunch at a city restaurant.

Day 3: MOSCOW - KREMLIN

Morning visit of the Kremlin : the beating heart of Russia's political world. The imposing walls house a number of stunning cathedrals & monuments. Guided visit of one of the Cathedrals. Afternoon free or optional tour. Continue sailing to Uglich at 5.30 pm.

Day 4: UGLITCH

Arrive at Uglich in the early afternoon. Enjoy a walking tour of the city and Kremlin. Founded in 1148, Uglich is one of the most beloved towns in old Russia.

Day 5: GORITSY

As we continue our journey, you will enjoy the breathtaking scenery as you sail through the White Lake and the Volga-Baltic Canal. You will visit in Goritsy the historic Kiril-Beloserskiy Men's Monastery founded in 1397. Sailing toward the Great Lakes of Karelia in the afternoon.

Day 6: KIZHI - PEARL OF KARELIA

Navigation through the White lake and then crossing of the Lake Onega to reach this tiny island located at the northern end of the Lake. Guided sightseeing tour including several examples of 19th-century peasant architecture; the Church of the Transfiguration with its 22 Domes, treasury of icons and its unique decorated screen; and at the Museum of Wooden Art. Walk through the Ethnographic Museum. All meals on board.

Day 7: MANDROGI

After sailing along the Svir River which connects the two Great Lakes of Onega and Ladoga in the heart of Karelia, we reach the tiny village of Mandrogi. Mandrogi, a modern make believe village gives a great opportunity to taste a varnished version of aestheticism. Picnic lunch (Weather permitting).

Day 8: SAINT-PETERSBURG

Arrival in the morning in the former capital of the Tsars'. Departure after breakfast for a sightseeing tour. You will see Nevsky Prospect, St Isaac's Cathedral, the Admiralty, the Church of the Spilled Blood and Peter and Paul's Fortress. All meals on board.

Day 9: SAINT-PETERSBURG

Visit to the Hermitage Art Gallery is perhaps one of Russia's best known sights but with arguably the greatest number

of secret treasures within its walls. Breakfast and dinner on board and lunch at a city restaurant.

Day 10: SAINT-PETERSBURG

Excursion to Peterhof. This is a magnificent summer residence and was built to rival Versailles. Situated on the shore of the Gulf of Finland, the palace's exterior facade and ornate interior are impressive in themselves. All meals on board.

Day 11: SAINT-PETERSBURG

After breakfast, disembarkation and bus transfer to the airport.

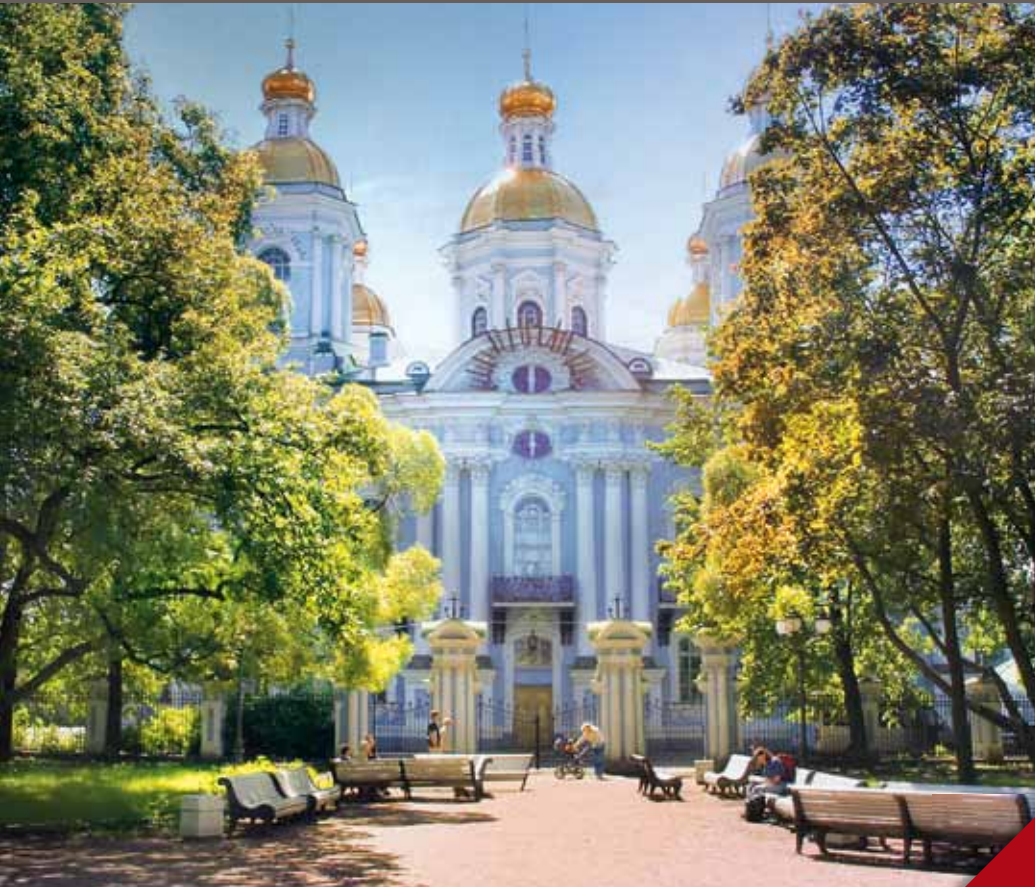
M/S KANDINSKY PRESTIGE

In 2015, always on the lookout for new ways, Rivages du Monde invites you to a unique cruising journey along the majestic Saint Lawrence Seaway. Aboard the R/V Saint Laurent Prestige, you will be offered a memorable trip throughout Ontario and the "Belle Province". This adventure tour proposes you nothing less than a nice combination of the biggest cities like Montreal and Toronto, scenic places like Quebec and Kingston with natural wonders like the Niagara Falls and the "Thousand Islands".

Day 1: MONTREAL

Embarkation on the M/V Saint-Laurent Prestige as from 16h. Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 2: NAVIGATION THROUGH THE « THOUSAND ISLANDS »

The M/V Saint Laurent Luxury sail all day in the so-called "Thousand Islands", a resort favored for over 100 years region. Many luxury hotels and several large fortunes are made build impressive villas as Bold Castle belonging to the founder of the famous Waldorf Astoria in New York.

Day 3: KINGSTON

Arrival in Kingston in the early morning and depart for a guided City tour of the city. Discover its history and its rich heritage: City Hall, Campus of the Royal Military College, Queen's University, the Penitentiary, the Cathedral of St. Mary's and the historic district. Visit of Bellevue House, former residence of Sir John A Macdonald, the first Prime Minister of Canada. Then visit Fort Henry, a World Heritage monument, which is housing today the museum of military life. The tour ends with a wine tasting at Huff Estates Winery (3 wines) one of the best vineyards in the region. Back on board for lunch. Afternoon at leisure or optional

excursion. Dinner and overnight on board. Night navigation on the Ontario Lake. *Optional excursion: Excursion to Ottawa, Canada's federal capital.*

Day 4: TORONTO

Guided city tour in the morning. Discover the old and the New City Hall building, Parliament, University, Chinatown (exterior views). Climb the CN Tower (TV Tower), which is also the symbol of the city and the tallest freestanding structure in the country. Walk to Kensington Market and Yorkville. Lunch on board. *Optional excursion: Visit the "Art Gallery of Ontario" and "Casa Loma".* The "Art Gallery of Ontario" contains important collections of European paintings including Breughel, Tintoretto, Rembrandt, Poussin and De La Tour. Then visit the "Casa Loma".

Day 5: NIAGARA FALLS

Arrival in the early morning at Port Weller and bus transfer towards the Niagara Falls. Discover the city of Niagara, including visiting Niagara Street Clifton Hill. Then embarka-

tion on board of the "Horn Blower", a small boat that leads passengers to the heart of the falls. Departure to Niagara-on-the-Lake, a charming village of Victorian style. Back to the ship and lunch on board. Dinner and overnight on board. *Optional helicopter tour of Niagara Falls (places limited).*

Day 6: OGDENSBURG (USA)

Navigation and lunch on board. Arriving early afternoon in the small American town of Ogdensburg. Ogdensburg is the only U.S. port on the south shore of the St. Lawrence River in upstate New York. Visit the museum dedicated to Frederic Remington, painter, draftsman and sculptor. Departure late afternoon towards Trois Rivières.

Day 7: NAVIGATION

During this day of sailing down the great St. Lawrence River, several events and conferences will be offered aboard the MV Saint Laurent Prestige.

Day 8: TROIS RIVIERES

Navigation in the morning. Arrival in early afternoon in Trois-Rivières, the third largest city in Quebec after Montreal and

The M/V Saint Laurent Prestige was built in 2001 in the shipyards of Atlantic Marine in Jacksonville (USA).

After a short drive, arriving at the Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré. Continuation to the island of Orleans, where you will enjoy a breathtaking view of Montmorency Falls and Quebec City.

Day 10: MONTREAL

Early morning arrival in Montreal, the "second largest French speaking city in the world". City tour by bus to discover the main attractions of the city: the harbor, Notre Dame Basilica, Mount Royal and its exceptional views over the city, the St. Catherine and St. Denis streets. Quick lunch on board and transfer to the airport or according to flight schedules, participation in an optional excursion: "Gastronomic tour of the Jean Talon Market". This tour is an opportunity to taste the specialties of the cuisine of Quebec's most famous farmers market in Montreal.



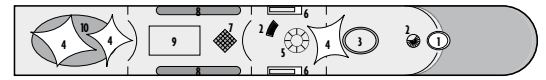
