

# BEAUTY COMES NATURALLY

The animals of the Galapagos are unlike any others on Earth. Apart from having no natural fear of humans, many have evolved into unique creatures that can only be seen here, which are on full display daily for you to see. This includes enormous 100-year-old Galapagos giant tortoises, free-diving marine iguanas, the beautiful and animated blue-footed boobies, and a host of other exotic fauna found nowhere else.

## THE FLORA

While the animals of the Galapagos Islands get the glory, the evolution and adaptation of plants here is equally important. Check out the beautiful lava cactus, which grows only on barren lava fields, the prickly pear cactus, found only on these islands, and the magnificent Scalesia tree, which grows up to 60 feet tall.

## THE FAUNA

Since the animals here don't fear humans, you can truly get up close and personal. Look into the eyes of a Galapagos iguana and swim among the only penguin species found north of the equator. Here, you'll meet the creatures whose very existence forms the basis for one of the most famous scientific theories in history.

## THE UNFORGETTABLE

You really haven't vacationed until you've hung out with a Blue-footed booby, come face to face with a Galapagos giant tortoise, and marveled at the sight of a magnificent frigate bird, not to mention Darwin's finches, more than 13 species that have adapted to different areas of the islands.

## THE ADVENTURE

Get ready for the snorkel experience of a lifetime. Here, you'll swim beside sea turtles and friendly, curious sea lions. They welcome you and swim along as if you were part of the family.



# LEAVING THE WORLD A BETTER PLACE

When you love traveling the planet as much as we do, being its steward is paramount. We're focused passionately on preserving the environment and partnering with local organizations on programs designed to improve the quality of life for residents of the Galapagos Islands. Since 2014, working in collaboration with the

Galapagos National Park and our naturalists, our guests have introduced more than 60,000 plants in support of the Scalesia reforestation effort. We're not only helping the wildlife that rely on these plants but also assuring that future generations get to experience this magical place—just as you can today.

## LOW-IMPACT TRAVEL

Your Galapagos experience upholds the highest standards of environmental stewardship. We care about the big things, like painting our hulls with non-toxic silicone to move our ships more efficiently with less fuel, plus the little things, like sourcing the chocolates on your pillow from a local Ecuador manufacturer that buys cacao from small producers in the region.

## THE GALAPAGOS ACADEMY

We launched the Galapagos Academy in 2021 to identify and develop local talent to provide them with high-level hospitality service training. This program engages permanent residents of the Galapagos in intensive and personalized training. It gives them a unique opportunity to learn about hospitality and working on a ship in a practical and personalized way.

## THE DAILY CATCH

Through the Galapagos Celebrity Fund, we worked with the local community to open a fishing co-op, which provides fishermen with a safe, clean processing plant to prepare, store, and sell their catch efficiently. Today, we serve the co-op's deliciously fresh, locally sourced, daily catch on board.

## THE GALAPAGOS FUND

We created the Galapagos Celebrity Fund together with the Galapagos Conservancy. The fund allows our guests to make a direct and lasting impact on the preservation of the region's rare flora and fauna, both marine and terrestrial. Since 2006, Celebrity and our guests have contributed over \$1.5 million to this fund for projects such as an art gallery for special needs children to display and sell their art to tourists and support women's entrepreneurship.





### DAY 13 • WEDNESDAY • THE SACRED VALLEY

Depart for the Urubamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas. Tour the ruins, featuring terraces

carved into the hillsides and a temple designed for worship and astronomical observation. Tour Ollantaytambo and the Pablo Seminario workshop, showcasing utilitarian and artistic objects. At Wayra Ranch, enjoy lunch—as you delight in stunning equestrian Peruvian Paso entertainment and Marinera music. Dine and spend the night at Tambo del Inka Luxury Collection.

### DAY 14 • THURSDAY • SACRED VALLEY / MACHU PICCHU\*

After breakfast at your hotel, you'll be transferred to the Ollantaytambo rail station, where you'll board the Vistadome train that will take you on a tour of the almost perfectly preserved buildings and mysterious passageways beneath the city. Lunch will be served at the Sanctuary Lodge, in Machu Picchu. Before leaving Machu Picchu, you'll enjoy tea time at the Sanctuary Lodge. Then later in the afternoon, you'll board the world-famous Belmond Hiram Bingham train for your journey back to Cuzco. On the train, you'll enjoy welcome aperitifs, dinner, and a selection of wines, as well as live local music, dancing, and Pisco sours. You'll arrive at the Belmond Monasterio Hotel, or similar, in Cuzco.

### DAY 15 • FRIDAY • CUZCO, PERU\*

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a scenic tour at the Coricancha, also known as the Temple of the Sun, before touring the Sacsayhuamán fortress and the cathedral, one of the most splendid Spanish colonial churches in America. It houses about 400 paintings from the Cuzco Art School, plus impressive gold, silver, and stone works. Lunch is served at a gourmet restaurant, with dinner at the Hotel Belmond Monasterio, or similar.

### DAY 16 • SATURDAY • CUZCO / LIMA, PERU

After breakfast at your hotel, you'll be taken to the airport for your morning flight back to Lima. Once in Lima, you'll visit the historic downtown, where you'll be served lunch at a gourmet restaurant. After lunch, you'll enjoy a tour of Peru's capital, with 2,000 years of history and colonial wealth, and discover the artistic tradition of the city's residents. You'll stop at Saint Francis' Convent, a masterpiece of colonial architecture, to visit its beautiful courtyards and catacombs. After your tour, you'll be taken to the Westin Lima Hotel for dinner. 
## LAS BACHAS, SANTA CRUZ ISLAND

Las Bachas Beach is located in the north of Santa Cruz Island. Its soft white sand is derived from coral and shells, making it a favorite nesting site for sea turtles. Behind the beach, there is a small brackish lagoon where it is possible to observe flamingos and other coastal birds, such as black-necked stilts and whimbrels.



## BALTRA ISLAND

During World War II, Baltra served as a U.S. military base protecting the Panama Canal from enemy attack. Now the cactus-strewn landscapes of Baltra are home to the region's main airport.



## BARONESS OUTLOOK, FLOREANA ISLAND

The Baroness' Viewing Point is the ideal place to take in the unique scenery that defines Floreana and to learn about the history of the island's early settlers. Once inhabited by an indulgent baroness and her three lovers, the island's history is intriguing.



## EL BARRANCO, GENOVESA ISLAND

El Barranco, also known as Prince Philip's Steps after the prince who visited in 1965 and again in 1981, is a steep stairway that leads up to a seabird colony full of Nazca and red-footed boobies. Once visitors reach the plateau, the trail continues inland and passes more nesting booby colonies in the *Palo Santo* forest.



## BARTOLOMÉ ISLAND

Bartolomé Island hosts one of the region's most often photographed views—a spectacular geologic setting. Its barren, moon-like volcanic landscapes, spatter cones, and pinnacle rock make for a unique stop. It is also home to the endemic Galapagos penguin and provides an excellent opportunity for snorkeling.



## BLACK TURTLE COVE, SANTA CRUZ ISLAND

A small boat ride into Black Turtle Cove brings you up close to the quiet wonders of the Galapagos. Once inside the cove, we'll quietly explore the area looking for sea turtles, several species of rays, and sharks.



## BUCCANEER COVE, SANTIAGO ISLAND

Buccaneer Cove is a testament to the fact that Santiago Island was once a refuge for British buccaneers. These pirates would anchor in the protected bay to make repairs and stock up on tortoise meat among other things.



## CHAMPION ISLAND, FLOREANA

Champion lies east of Floreana and provides a wonderful opportunity for snorkeling and boat rides. Colorful tropical fish abound, with frequent sightings of sea turtles, rays, sharks, sea stars, and more.



## CHINESE HAT ISLET

This small volcanic islet near the southeastern coast of Santiago Island is shaped amazingly like a Chinese hat, or "sombrero chino" in Spanish. It is formed of hardened lava and spatter cones, which make for scenic photos. Several species of Darwin's finches are found on the island. Along the coast, you will find sea lions and colorful Sally lightfoot crabs.




**CORMORANT POINT, FLOREANA ISLAND**  
 Floreana was the first capital of the Galapagos and where Charles Darwin met the islands' governor. Its small brackish lagoon is often home to flamingos, stilts, and white-cheeked pintail ducks. One of its beaches is a highly used nesting site for sea turtles. Check out the green-hued sand where you land.




**DAPHNE MAJOR**  
 Daphne is a satellite volcanic cone located north of Santa Cruz Island. This island is famous for the scientific investigation led by Peter and Rosemary Grant on the finches' population, one of the most important studies in the field that supports Charles Darwin's theory.





**DARWIN BAY, GENOVESA ISLAND**  
 Darwin Bay's soft white sand is only the beginning of a spectacular day. A trail from the beach takes you into lush mangroves where red-footed boobies nest. Other local wildlife includes sea lions, swallow-tailed gulls, frigatebirds, and more.



**DRAGON HILL, SANTA CRUZ ISLAND**  
 Dragon Hill, or Cerro Dragón in Spanish, is named after its population of land iguanas. The site offers a beautiful view of the landscape and two small brackish lagoons where flamingos and other shore birds sometimes feed. Along the trail, we'll cross a beautiful "white forest" of *palo santo* (incense) trees and Galapagos cotton plants.



**EGAS PORT, SANTIAGO ISLAND**  
 With its black sand beach, coastal tide pools, and blue-water grottoes, this stop offers a wonderful taste of the Galapagos and an opportunity to see shore birds, Galapagos hawks, sea lions, marine iguanas, and Galapagos fur seals. Sea lions, colorful tropical fish, and sea turtles are often seen while snorkeling, conditions permitting.



**ELIZABETH BAY, ISABELA ISLAND**  
 Elizabeth Bay is one of the westernmost points in the Galapagos. A scenic small boat ride within this sheltered inlet offers viewing of a wide variety of wildlife and a wonderful mangrove ecosystem.

**ESPINOZA POINT, FERNANDINA ISLAND**  
 Fernandina is the youngest island in the Galapagos and, as Darwin wrote, it is "covered with immense deluges of black naked lava." Along with its extraordinary black lava rocks, this point of land hosts the largest colony of marine iguanas in the archipelago, along with sea lions and a nesting site for flightless cormorants.

**ESPUMILLA BEACH, SANTIAGO ISLAND**  
 Located on the northern coast of Santiago Island in James Bay, this beach is a sea turtle nesting site. Favored attractions are the *palo santo* forest, beach, and lovely landscape. The trail passes a small seasonal lagoon, where flamingos and white-cheeked pintail ducks are seen, then loops through an arid zone, where some of the tallest *palo santo* trees are found.

**GARDNER BAY, ESPAÑOLA ISLAND**  
 The beach at Gardner Bay, with its sparkling white sand, offers one of the best places in the Galapagos to relax and swim. It's home to one of the most important colonies of sea lions, and it provides a nesting site for sea turtles. Three species of Darwin's finches and Española mockingbirds may be seen here.

**KICKER ROCK, SAN CRISTOBAL ISLAND**  
 Kicker Rock or León Dormido, named for its shape—either a boot or a sleeping lion—is a dramatic sight. These remains of a volcanic tuff cone rise almost 148 m straight up out of the ocean. Erosion has split the rock in two, forming a narrow channel between.




**ISLA LOBOS, SAN CRISTÓBAL ISLAND**  
 Named after its large colony of sea lions, this island usually allows visitors to observe their pups, especially while snorkeling. In addition, we may see blue-footed boobies, frigatebirds, even a glimpse at the second type of sea lion species found in Galapagos, the fur sea lion. It is a seasonal nesting location for blue-footed boobies and frigatebirds.



**MORENO POINT, ISABELA ISLAND**  
 Along this beautiful rocky shore, a field of hardened black lava flows is pockmarked by shallow pools, which are home to shorebirds and flamingos. The mangrove-lined shore also provides a chance to see marine iguanas, sea turtles, stingrays, sharks, penguins, and flightless cormorants.



**MOSQUERA ISLET**  
 This small, flat, sandy islet sits in the channel between Baltra and North Seymour islands. It is almost devoid of vegetation but has one of the largest populations of sea lions in the islands. Its sandy expanse offers visitors the perfect opportunity to observe the behavior of sea lions, lava gulls, coastal birds, and Sally lightfoot crabs.



**NORTH SEYMOUR ISLAND**  
 North Seymour is a small island just north of Baltra, home to the largest colony of frigatebirds in the Galapagos. While watching for male frigatebirds trying to impress potential mates with an inflated red neck pouch, you may also see blue-footed boobies dancing in their timeless courtship ritual.



**POST OFFICE BAY, FLOREANA ISLAND**  
 Rich in history, this site is home to a post office barrel, established circa 1793, where pirates, buccaneers, whalers, and others have left their mail to be picked up by outbound ships. The tradition continues today, as visitors leave addressed postcards in the barrel and sort through mail left in it to deliver back home.




**PUERTO AYORA, SANTA CRUZ ISLAND**  
 This is the major population center of the islands and home to the tortoise-breeding center of the National Park Service and the Charles Darwin Research Station, both of which you can visit.



**PUERTO BAQUERIZO MORENO, SAN CRISTÓBAL ISLAND**  
 Here we have the opportunity to visit the small waterfront town of Puerto Baquerizo Moreno, the administrative capital of the islands.




**PUERTO VILLAMIL, ISABELA ISLAND**  
 Welcome to the small, laid-back town of Puerto Villamil. An interpretive trail 1.5 km from town takes you around the secluded wetland lagoons to the tortoise center, created to protect baby tortoises from threats by foreign species such as pigs and donkeys. The center educates visitors about Galapagos giant tortoises, and you can see both hatchlings and older breeding animals.



**PUNTA PITT, SAN CRISTÓBAL**  
 At the northeastern tip of San Cristóbal Island, disembark onto the small green sand beach and hike up to the plateau, where a spectacular view makes it worth the effort. A steep gully leads up the cliff to a breeding ground for all three species of boobies: red-footed, blue-footed, and Nazca. It's the only place in the Galapagos where you can see all three nesting together.



**RÁBIDA ISLAND**  
 A small island south of Santiago, Rábida is best known for its red sand and eroded volcanic landscape. A nesting colony of pelicans makes its home here, along with sea lions and some sea birds.




### LAS TINTORERAS ISLET

Named after the Spanish word for whitetip reef shark, Las Tintoreras is an islet offshore Puerto Villamil, Isabela. A magnificent volcanic landscape with lichen-covered lava rocks leads to a narrow channel where whitetip reef sharks are often found resting on the bottom. Large marine iguanas, sea turtles, rays, sea lions, blue-footed boobies and Galapagos penguins are also observed here.




### SANTA FE ISLAND

Your visit to Santa Fe begins with a wet landing on the small beach at Barrington Bay. Sea lions populate these beaches and often surf the waves. Species here include the massive Santa Fe opuntia cactus, Galapagos hawk, Galapagos snake, Galapagos mockingbird, rice rats, and various finches. You'll hike past saltbush, where Galapagos hawks and Santa Fe land iguanas roam.



### SOUTH PLAZA ISLAND

One of the islands off Santa Cruz, South Plaza was born of upheaval, uplifted during a geologic event. The rocky island is strewn with prickly pear cactus and home to land iguanas, marine iguanas, and a colony of sea lions.



### SUAREZ POINT, ESPAÑOLA ISLAND

Española is the oldest island here, and Suarez Point is home to Nazca and blue-footed boobies, Española lava lizards, Galapagos hawks, Española mockingbirds, Darwin's finches, Galapagos doves, swallow-tailed gulls, and red-billed tropic birds. Seen from April to December, the 10,000-12,000 pairs of waved albatross represent the vast majority of this species on the planet.



### SULLIVAN BAY, SANTIAGO ISLAND

During a volcanic eruption in the early 1900s, this area flowed with lava. Today, the hardened fields of black rock create a geologic wonderland. We'll take advantage of the cool early morning to view twisting, hardened lava flows, collapse craters, and everyone's favorite, the *hornitos*, or lava ovens. Tall red scoria cones and pioneer plants dot the young landscape.



### TAGUS COVE, ISABELA ISLAND

Historically an anchorage for pirates and whalers, this site offers a breathtaking view of Isabela, its volcanoes, and spectacular Darwin Lake. Along the shore, seabirds, penguins, sea lions, sea turtles, and nesting flightless cormorants can be found.



### URVINA BAY, ISABELA ISLAND

Composed of five coalesced volcanoes, Isabela is the largest island in the Galapagos and the most recently active. The latest eruption was in 2015. Here we will see land iguanas, finches, and if we're lucky, a giant tortoise. In 1954, the intrusion of magma below a volcano caused the bay to lift up some 6 m, and today we can hike the remains of what was once a thriving underwater reef.

### VICENTE ROCA POINT, ISABELA ISLAND

The half-collapsed remains of an ancient volcano make for a spectacular setting at this site. Awe-inspiring cliffs, blue waters, and wildlife create a boat ride to remember, as we search for sea turtles, penguins, fur seals, flightless cormorants, marine iguanas, marine mammals, and oddly shaped sunfish.



### WARLOCK HILL (CERRO BRUJO), SAN CRISTÓBAL ISLAND

On the north coast of San Cristóbal Island, Cerro Brujo is the eroded remains of a volcanic tuff cone and one of the first sites visited by Charles Darwin. Captain Fitzroy climbed to the top of the hill to scout the reefs. A favorite attraction here is the gorgeous white sand beach, a wonderful place to swim or take a walk along the shoreline.

### BOOKING A CRUISE

**Minimum Age; Pregnancy and Infants:** Celebrity's minimum age to sail unaccompanied on a Galapagos cruise is 21. Any Guest under the age of 21 must travel with a parent or legal guardian or such other person as may be permitted by Celebrity's policies. Pregnant women who will enter the 24th week or more of estimated fetal gestational age at any time during the Cruise or CruiseTour will be ineligible to sail, and agree not to book the cruise. Infants under the age of twelve (12) months are not permitted on Galapagos cruises. The most current minimum age requirements are available online at [www.celebritycruises.com](http://www.celebritycruises.com).

### DEPOSITS/PAYMENTS

**Minimum Deposits:** In order to reserve a stateroom or suite on a Galapagos cruise, a minimum deposit of US\$450 per person is required for staterooms, and US\$900 per person for suites. The minimum deposit must be received within seven (7) days of booking, depending on time prior to departure. Final payment of the balance due for a Galapagos cruise must be received at Celebrity's offices at least 120 days prior to the scheduled embarkation date. If you book your cruise through a travel advisor, you may pay us directly via credit card or provide payment to your travel advisor. Travel advisors: Make checks payable to Celebrity Cruises Inc., P.O. Box 025511, Miami, FL 33102-5511. Express mail or courier deliveries shall be sent to Celebrity Cruises Inc., 1050 Caribbean Way, Miami, FL 33132, Attn: Cash Processing Department. If you book your cruise directly with Celebrity, you may pay Celebrity via credit card, money order or personal check. Celebrity accepts the following credit cards: Visa®, MasterCard®, American Express®, Optima®, Diners Club International®, and Discover® card.

### CANCELLATION CHARGES/REFUNDS

If you cancel your cruise reservation, you may be subject to a cancellation charge. The amount of the cancellation charge shall be determined as shown in the table in your Cruise Ticket Contract and will depend on how far in advance of the sail date (or first day of the CruiseTour) Celebrity receives notice of cancellation.

**As of April 1, 2022, the cancellation charges for Galapagos cruises are as follows:**

Days-prior-to-sailing charges, per person:

**119-89 days:** Deposit (\$450 for staterooms; \$900 for suites)

**88-43 days:** 50% of total cruise fare

**42-22 days:** 75% of total cruise fare

**21 days or less:** No refund except for Taxes/Fees

For bookings made outside of the United States and Canada, a different cancellation policy may apply. Contact your local Celebrity office or travel agency for details. The above schedule and cancellation charges are subject to change. Please refer to [www.celebritycruises.com](http://www.celebritycruises.com) prior to booking and your ticket contract for the cancellation charges that apply to your cruise booking.

If you cancel your Cruise or CruiseTour reservation prior to sailing, any applicable Taxes/Fees or fuel supplement surcharges shall be fully refunded. No refunds will be made in the event of a no-show or if you interrupt your cruise. Any refunds due from Celebrity will be made to the original form of payment (i.e., to your credit card if you paid Celebrity by credit card, or to your travel agent, if you made payment to your travel agent). Celebrity is not responsible for any payments you made to your travel agent that are not paid to Celebrity, or any refunds that Celebrity has provided to your travel agent.

Travel advisor may impose their own charges in connection with a cruise. For example, the travel advisor may charge a flat service fee for assistance with your reservations and a value-added charge for additional amenities or services being provided by the travel advisor. In addition, travel agents may impose their own cancellation fees. Any charges or fees of this nature are a matter strictly between you and your travel advisor.

### TRAVEL DOCUMENTS; HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

You are responsible for bringing all travel documents, such as passports, visas, proof of citizenship, and proof of mandatory inoculations, required for boarding the vessel in Ecuador and for entry or re-entry into any countries through which the voyage or other travel arrangements will take you. The Ecuadorian Galapagos law requires tourists to have travel insurance with medical coverage.

**At a minimum, you will be required by Ecuadorian law to have a valid passport with at least six months validity from the departure date from Ecuador.** It is your sole responsibility to identify all travel, inoculation, and health requirements and obtain and have available when necessary the appropriate valid travel documents, yellow fever certificates, and other health requirements. If you do not possess the proper documentation, you may be prevented from boarding your flight or ship, and from debarking or entering a country, and may be subject to fines.

*Important Note: the name on your reservation must be exactly as it is stated on your passport. Otherwise,*

*you may be denied boarding. Visit [celebrity.com/documentation](http://celebrity.com/documentation) for up-to-date information on documentation.*

If you fail to supply the details requested fully and accurately, you may not be permitted to board the ship or your flight. If, as a result of your failure to comply with the foregoing, Celebrity incurs any fines, surcharges, or other financial penalty, you will be responsible for reimbursing Celebrity accordingly.*

You must ensure that you are medically fit for travel. As such, we remind you to check with your physician at least 4-6 weeks before sailing to make sure you are up to date with any required immunizations and vaccines you will need to ensure you will be permitted to board the ship and visit each of the exciting destinations and tours on the itinerary.

To expedite the boarding process, all guests must complete Celebrity's online check-in process, providing proof of citizenship and identification, and emergency contact information as part of the process, at least 72 hours prior to sailing. ### SPECIAL NEEDS

Please note the ability to accommodate guests with special needs onboard vessels in the Galapagos Islands is limited. The Galapagos vessels cannot accommodate guests who are full-time wheelchair users and do not offer accessible staterooms. In addition, the land portion of these vacations, including Quito and Galapagos in Ecuador, as well as Lima, Cuzco, and Machu Picchu in Peru, are not suited to persons who are full-time wheelchair users. On a Celebrity Galapagos vacation, you must be able to ascend or descend steps into a motor coach, walk and/or climb over uneven ground for extended distances, get on and off tenders on both wet and dry landings, and be able to climb stairs. Celebrity Flora® has an elevator but Celebrity Xpedition® and Celebrity Xploration® do not. Guests should be reminded that Celebrity is not required to provide personal assistance (e.g. assisting with eating, dressing, toileting, lifting, etc.). Guests requiring assistance with these functions should consider this when making a booking. Guests with special needs should contact our Access Department in writing via email at **[special\\_needs@celebrity.com](mailto:special_needs@celebrity.com)** or via fax at **1-954-628-9622**.

### Availability of Medical Care.

Celebrity Flora and Celebrity Xpedition are each equipped with a medical facility. One licensed physician (licensed under Ecuadorian law) is normally in attendance on board. Due to the nature of travel by sea and the ports visited, the availability of medical care onboard the vessel and in ports of call may be limited or delayed and medical evacuation may not be possible from the vessel while at sea or from every location to which the vessel sails. The medications kept on board are extremely limited, and guests must bring an adequate supply of any medications they need. The medical facility is not intended or designed to serve as a clinic for guests, and the use of those facilities (including any medications obtained therefrom) will result in a charge to the guest. For Celebrity Xploration sailings, please note the vessel does not have a doctor on board nor a medical facility.

### PACKING FOR ADVENTURE

What does one pack when one is visiting some of the most unique islands in the world? Surprisingly, many of the same things you would take with you to visit any foreign destination. However, when deciding what to pack, be aware that air carriers limit each guest to one

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checked bag (44 lbs.) and one carry-on (17 lbs.).

#### DAYTIME AND DESTINATION EXPERIENCES

- Neutral-colored clothing is advised due to possible presence of insects.
- Lightweight rain jacket or windbreaker.
- A small backpack to carry water and other essentials.
- A hat, sunglasses, sunblock, and insect repellent.
- A resealable plastic bag to prevent water damage to cameras and other items of that nature.
- If you bring a digital camera, be sure to pack plenty of memory cards.
- The weather in these ports of call can be unpredictable, so we recommend layers. During the warmer months (February to June) it can be very hot on shore.
- Lightweight shorts and pants as well as both long-sleeve and short-sleeve shirts.
- A jacket or sweatshirt will come in handy for cooler days and evenings.
- Sturdy, comfortable walking shoes or lightweight hiking boots, thick socks, swimsuit, and waterproof sandals or wet/dry water shoes for the beach and wet landings. Some of the island trails require walking on rocks, so be sure to have support and good tread on walking shoes.

#### EVENING

- As you pack evening clothes, you should remember that there is no need for formal attire.
- For women, we recommend pants and skirts, or even casual dresses.
- For men, we recommend comfortable shirts and pants, along with a sweater or light jacket.

Ultimately, the goal is to take whatever clothing, shoes, and supplies will allow you to focus your time and attention on what matters most: immersing yourselves in the beauty and history of the Galapagos Islands.

#### WHAT NOT TO PACK

Weapons, illegal drugs, and other items that could interfere with the safe operation of the ship or the safe and secure environment of our guests and crew, are prohibited. More detailed information on prohibited items is available for review at [celebrity.com/packing](https://celebrity.com/packing). The following are examples of items that guests are not allowed to bring onboard: knives, illegal drugs, candles, coffee makers, clothes irons, hot plates, electrical transformers, flammable liquids, explosives, dangerous chemicals, martial arts gear, handcuffs, HAM radios, and alcoholic beverages not in accordance with the Alcoholic Beverages Policy.

To protect the destinations we visit, we recommend avoiding sunscreens containing:

- Petrolatum (aka mineral oil) - takes a long time to biodegrade and is harmful or even fatal to local wildlife.

- Titanium Dioxide - does not biodegrade and is harmful to all sea life.
- Oxybenzone, octocrylene, and octinoxate - are banned from use in some locations, as they cause damage to reef systems.
