MEDITERRANEAN FEATURED PORTS

AGADIR, MOROCCO

On the Atlantic coast of North Africa, Agadir is full of surprising wonders like The Agadir Oufella ruins (also known as the Kasbah); golden sand beaches; the Souk El Had d'Agadir which is one of the country's largest markets; and the rich history of the old city, parks, and sand dunes.

LAS PALMAS, CANARY ISLANDS, SPAIN

An exotic mix of Spanish and African cultures, with touches of the New World, this island city is home to the Museo Canaria, beautiful beaches, the fascinating Elder Museum of Science and Technology, and the UNESCO World Heritage section of town, La Vegueta, and its nearby shops and cafés.

CASABLANCA, MOROCCO

Morocco's largest city and main commercial hub fuses Arab-Muslim heritage and colonial influences with a bold modernity. Wander its maze-like medina and admire the downtown's mix of Moorish architecture and French art deco design. The landmark Hassan II Mosque, dominated by its 688-foot-high minaret and built partially over water, accommodates an astounding 100,000 worshippers.

SYRACUSE, SICILY, ITALY

Its incredible wealth of well-preserved historic monuments, spanning the Greek, Roman, Byzantine, Ottoman, and Baroque eras prompted UNESCO to name the entire city of Syracuse a World Heritage Site.

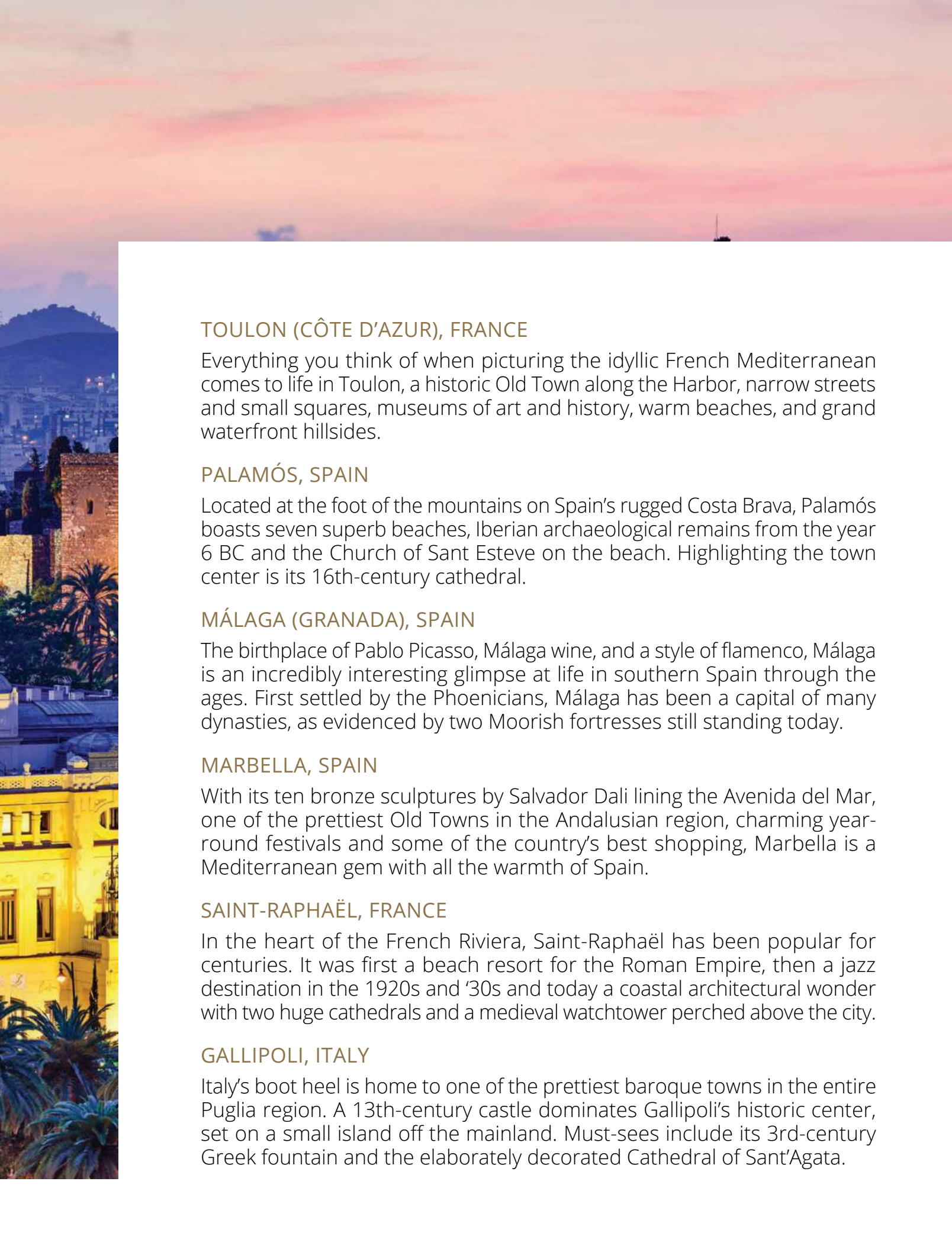
L'ÎLE-ROUSSE, CORSICA, FRANCE

Located on the northwest coast of Corsica, L'Île-Rousse was originally founded in the 18th century and named for the distinctive red rocks that color the shore. A charming main square and 120-year-old date palms are in the main town. Or, head to the lighthouse for views above the village.





MÁLAGA, SPAIN



TOULON (CÔTE D'AZUR), FRANCE

Everything you think of when picturing the idyllic French Mediterranean comes to life in Toulon, a historic Old Town along the Harbor, narrow streets and small squares, museums of art and history, warm beaches, and grand waterfront hillsides.

PALAMÓS, SPAIN

Located at the foot of the mountains on Spain's rugged Costa Brava, Palamós boasts seven superb beaches, Iberian archaeological remains from the year 6 BC and the Church of Sant Esteve on the beach. Highlighting the town center is its 16th-century cathedral.

MÁLAGA (GRANADA), SPAIN

The birthplace of Pablo Picasso, Málaga wine, and a style of flamenco, Málaga is an incredibly interesting glimpse at life in southern Spain through the ages. First settled by the Phoenicians, Málaga has been a capital of many dynasties, as evidenced by two Moorish fortresses still standing today.

MARBELLA, SPAIN

With its ten bronze sculptures by Salvador Dali lining the Avenida del Mar, one of the prettiest Old Towns in the Andalusian region, charming year-round festivals and some of the country's best shopping, Marbella is a Mediterranean gem with all the warmth of Spain.

SAINT-RAPHAËL, FRANCE

In the heart of the French Riviera, Saint-Raphaël has been popular for centuries. It was first a beach resort for the Roman Empire, then a jazz destination in the 1920s and '30s and today a coastal architectural wonder with two huge cathedrals and a medieval watchtower perched above the city.

GALLIPOLI, ITALY

Italy's boot heel is home to one of the prettiest baroque towns in the entire Puglia region. A 13th-century castle dominates Gallipoli's historic center, set on a small island off the mainland. Must-sees include its 3rd-century Greek fountain and the elaborately decorated Cathedral of Sant'Agata.

PORTOFINO, ITALY

Portofino is a popular, picturesque resort village on the Italian Riviera, favored by artists and travelers for its breathtaking views of villas arrayed like an immense, colorful amphitheatre on steep slopes above a cerulean bay.

ST. TROPEZ, FRANCE

The modern glamour never really deserts this town famous for Bardot and a film festival, but the venerable village perché of Grimaud in the nearby Maures Massif has an 11th-century Grimaud castle with links to Monaco's ruling Grimaldis.

PALMA DE MALLORCA, SPAIN

Spain's sunny Mediterranean outpost is a pleasant spot boasting a shady plaza near the Gothic cathedral. Perhaps journey to the enchanting village of Valldemossa, but leave time to shop for false (but lovely) Majorica pearls and handmade lace.

AMALFI, ITALY

One of the two main towns on the famed Amalfi drive, Amalfi is known for its stunning beaches, majestic Duomo di Sant'Andrea cathedral, colorful Majolica tiles, the Chiostro del Paradiso cloister gardens and the Museo della Carta where you can make paper using the traditional medieval methods.

VALLETTA, MALTA

Diversity thrives in Malta, which has been occupied by the Phoenicians, Greeks, Carthaginians, Romans, Arabs, French, and British throughout history. Valletta, the current-day capital echoes a rich past that includes the St. John's Co-Cathedral and Museum, Palace of the Grand Masters and many fortifications.







BONIFACIO, CORSICA, FRANCE



GIBRALTAR, BRITISH OVERSEAS TERRITORY

Fabled to be one of the Pillars of Hercules that marked the edge of the world, “The Rock” of Gibraltar is a towering monolith of limestone and marble with natural caves, manmade tunnels, and geological significance. Its position between Africa and Europe makes for a fascinating history.

CARTAGENA (MURCIA), SPAIN

In the 3rd century BC, the Romans seized the rich harbor town of Cartagena from Carthage in a famous battle. The 2,000-year-old amphitheatre, an altar to Jupiter, and other ruins remain alongside colonial architecture, grand museums, military forts and castles, and other monuments to history.

VALENCIA, SPAIN

Located in Europe’s most dense agricultural region, Valencia was originally a Greek settlement, before being turned into a retirement village for Roman soldiers in 138 BC. Later, the Moors controlled the land before and after El Cid, before it permanently became part of Spain in the 15th century.

IBIZA, SPAIN

Glistening with whitewashed houses and a sandstone walled city at the top of the hillside, Ibiza is often called Isla Blanca or White Island. Tranquil beachfront coves, high-end fashion, a thriving art scene, renaissance architecture, and Michelin-starred restaurants are all lesser-known treats

BONIFACIO, CORSICA, FRANCE

The scent of wild maquis carries to the island of Corsica, birthplace of Napoleon Bonaparte. Bonifacio and its medieval citadel perch atop the southern coast’s limestone cliffs; wander the old town’s cobblestone streets and piazzas abuzz with craft shops, bars and brasseries. Fine-sand beaches and hidden pirate coves are plentiful.

PORTOFERRAIO, ELBA, ITALY

Though small, Elba has been known since the beginnings of recorded history – prized by empire after empire for its rich soil and abundance of minerals and gems. Napoleon’s famous exile in the 1800s still bears signs of his stay here, yet the largely agricultural island is serene and timeless.

PORTOVENERE (CINQUE TERRE), ITALY

The “Golfo dei Poeti,” inspired Dante, Petrarch, Byron, and Shelley with ancient houses and a dominant 12th-century citadel. Explore the grotto where Byron pondered, or climb the castle beside St. Peter’s church for a view of the Cinque Terre villages.

LA CIOTAT, FRANCE

With its quintessential French Riviera atmosphere, La Ciotat was actually the original cinema hot-spot on the Côte d’Azur, well before Cannes and St. Tropez. Besides gorgeous beaches, it is home to the first commercial film in history and the birthplace of color photography.

GOLFO ARANCI, SARDINIA, ITALY

The Sardinian coastline is serrated by deep-cut coves of sparkling sea, surrounded by rocky prominences, and edged in lovely strands of beach. The Aga Khan fell in love with the place, and dubbed it the Costa Smeralda, creating a magnet for the global glitterati, who adore its silvery white sands.

ROSAS (ROSES), SPAIN

This port town along Spain’s sunny Costa Brava is as pretty as the flower for which it is named. Explore its 16th-century castle, visit the buzzy fish market, and discover golden-sand beaches and hidden coves galore. Nearby lie the megalithic dolmen of Creu d’en Cobertella and Greco-Roman archaeological site of Empúries.

MARINA GRANDE, ISOLA DI CAPRI, ITALY

Colorful fishing boats line this busy little port, entry to the fabled isle of Capri. Travelers since Homer’s Odysseus have been enchanted by its rugged landscape, turquoise waters and ethereal Blue Grotto. Stroll the town of Capri’s narrow alleyways lined with exclusive boutiques, or just sit in the central piazza and soak in the charm.

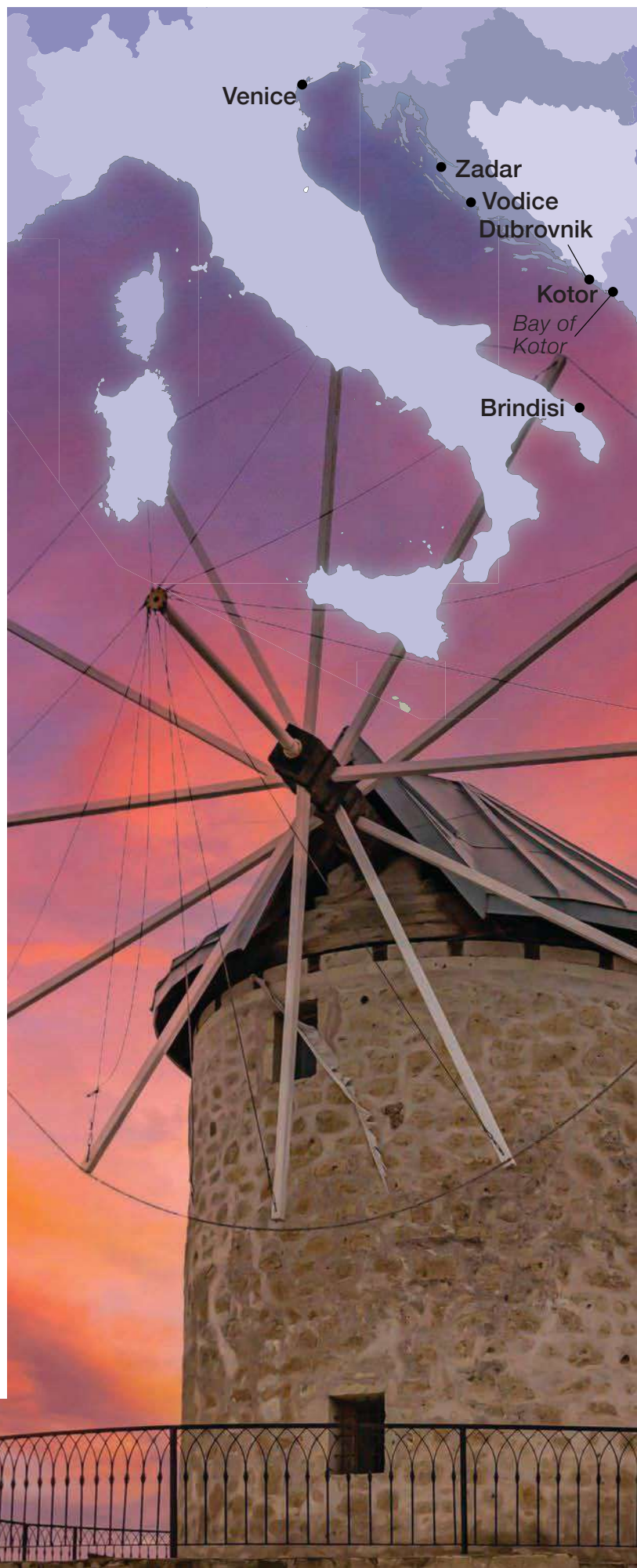

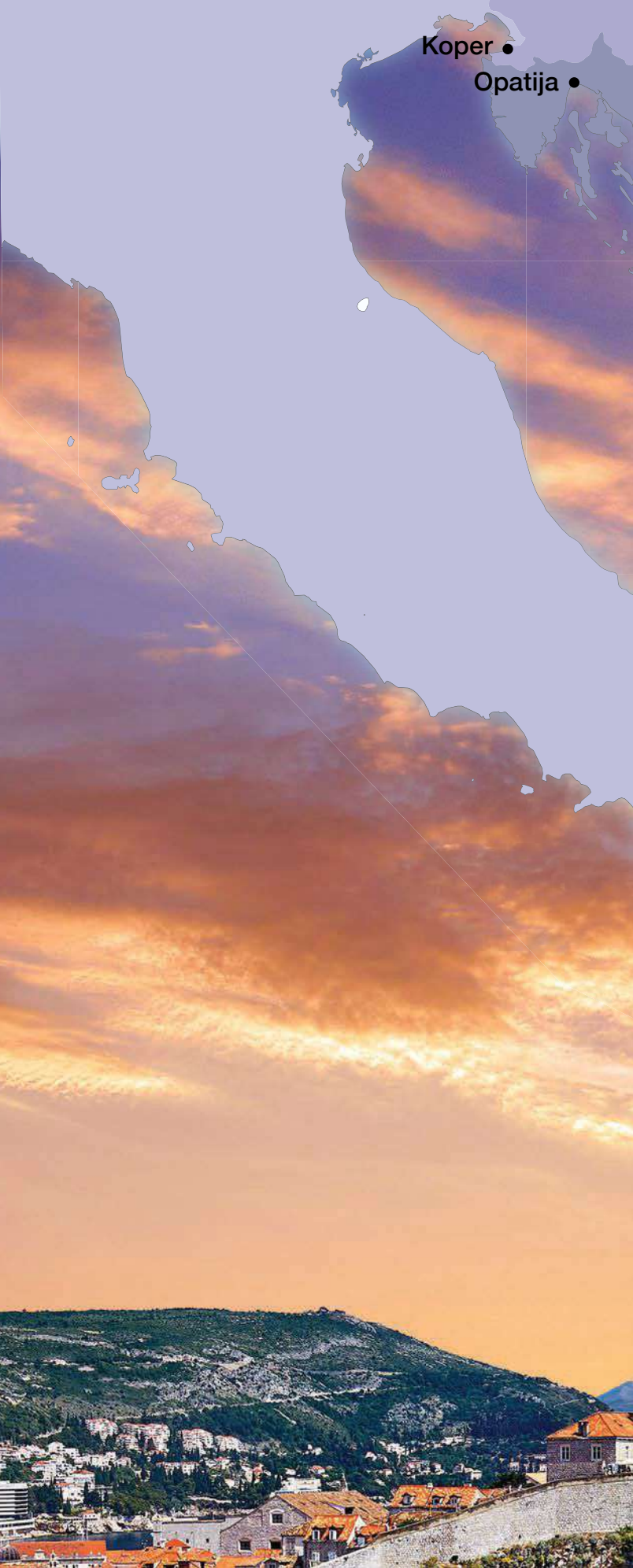

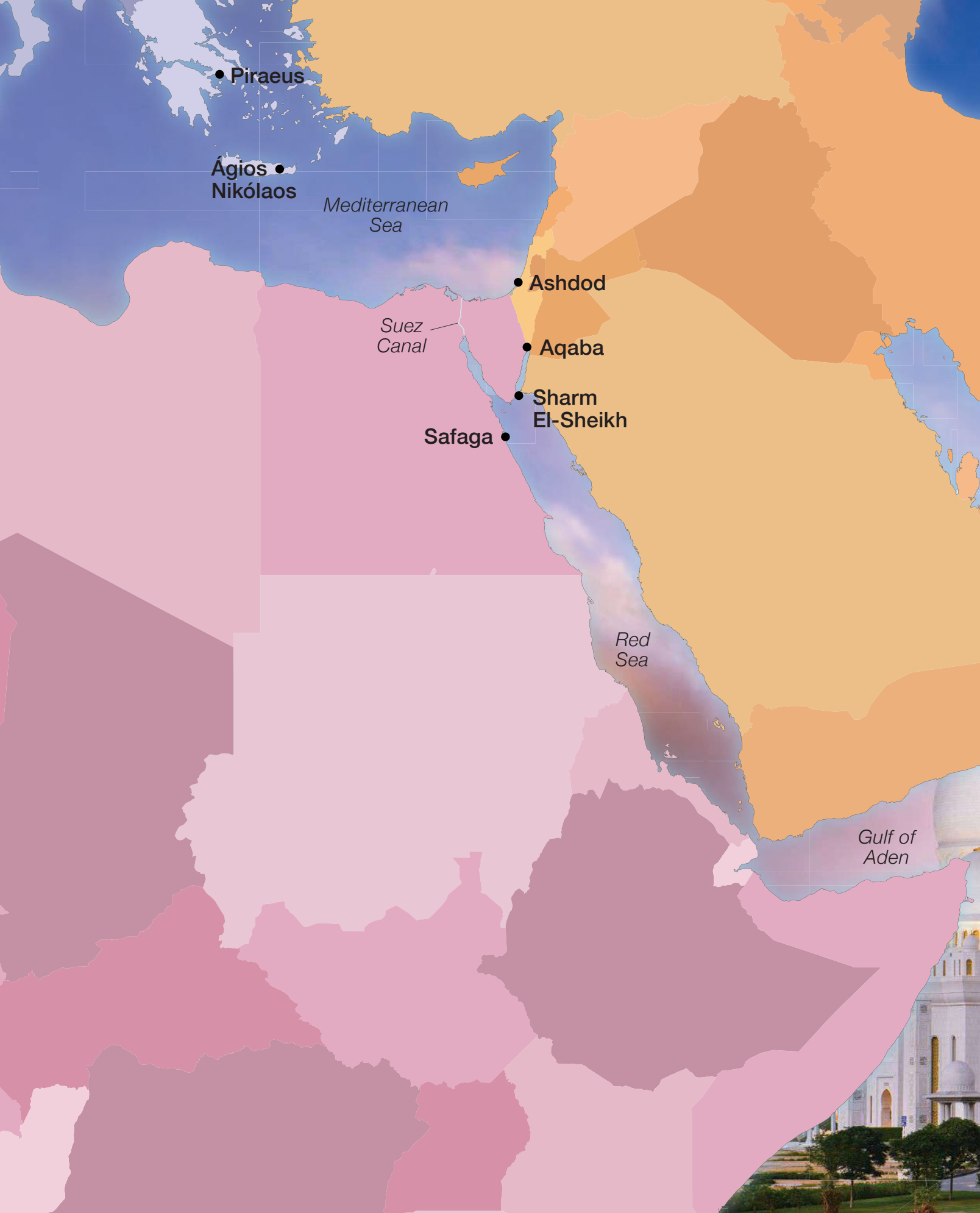

FEATURED PORTS

MONEMVASIA, GREECE

Its name means 'one entrance' and this tall isle has only one way in. Honeycombed with grottoes, narrow alleys and rock-carved rooms, the narrow pathways lead up to the Byzantine Agia Sophia church, and a medieval fortress and walls.

VODICE (ŠIBENIK), CROATIA

Among the familiar red-tiled roofs of the Dalmatian Coast, you'll find the towers and manors from the 17th century, the Parish Church of St. Cross from 1746, the old Church of St. Cross from 1402, and the Church of St. Elijah from 1298. Roman ruins date back even further, to around 160 BC.

SÁMI, CEPHALONIA, GREECE

This lovely harbor on Cephalonia is close to Antisamos beach, the setting for the film *Captain Corelli's Mandolin*; the ethereal beauty of the underground lake in Melissani Cave; and to the ruins of ancient Sámi, occupied for millennia.

LIMASSOL, CYPRUS

Along with ten miles of meandering shoreline, Limassol features mountain villages, castles and basilicas; ancient archaeological sites dating back to 7,000 BC; vineyards; an upscale marina town with friendly restaurants; and chic fashion and jewelry boutiques.

AGIOS NIKÓLAOS, CRETE, GREECE

This major resort town in Crete is a tale of two waters, the seas of Mirabello Bay and the island's famous Lake Voulismeni. Both waterfronts are lined with cafés, shops, and sunny beaches. Walk around town to discover statues to Greek mythology, local olive oil, and folk art.



ISTANBUL, TURKEY



CHANIA, GREECE

Chania is a land of exotic beauty and sandy beaches at the foot of imposing mountains. Large caves, rivers, lush green plains, and rich flora and fauna surround the harbor and its old-meets-new mix of Venetian fortifications from the 1500s and modern buildings and storefronts.

MYKONOS, NISOS MYKONOS, GREECE

This quintessential Greek island is known for its whitewashed houses, domed churches, windmills and dashes of bright blue from doors, shutters, window frames, and the sea and sky. Explore the colorful harbor on foot, or hop on a scooter to cruise by beaches, bistros and shops.

ÇESME, TURKEY

As a destination that's off the typical tourist path, Çeşme has a quiet authenticity in its charm. Uncrowded beaches, rolling fields of olive trees, bougainvillea-lined streets, hot springs, local art, a medieval castle, and other historic sites all wait to welcome you.

ISTANBUL, TURKEY

Byzantium's domes and minarets are unmistakable. This is the Golden Horn, the door between East and West. Hagia Sophia, the Blue Mosque, and Topkapi Sarai await—as does the Grand Bazaar, laden with carpets, beaten brass, and spices from afar.

IZMIR (PERGAMON), TURKEY

The birthplace of the epic poet Homer, Izmir has grown into a thriving metropolis with a sweeping bayfront. Museums of archaeology and ethnography, and the remnants of ancient Smyrna's 4th-century fort atop Mt. Pagos are interesting glimpses into the city's rich past.

ITEA (DELPHI), GREECE

This quiet seaside town serves as gateway to the archaeological site of Delphi, which ancient Greeks deemed the center of the world. Head up Mt. Parnassus's steep slopes to the Temple of Apollo, where the city's famous oracle delivered her divine prophesies. Explore the 4th-century amphitheater and other impressive ruins.

PÁTAMOS, NISOS PÁTAMOS, GREECE

According to myth, Artemis and Apollo entreated to Zeus to raise Pátmos from the sea. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site important to Christian history. A monastery overlooks a cave believed to be where the biblical "Book of Revelations" was written.

SKÍATHOS, NISOS SKÍATHOS, GREECE

Skíathos is a popular Sporades island blessed with forests, fruit and olive orchards, and vineyards. Its 60 beaches include the famous Koukounaries and remote Lalaria with its picturesque rock arch.

SANTORÍNI, GREECE

Santoríni's anchorage, between sheer walls of a collapsed volcanic caldera, is an iconic Greek isles harbor. Ascend to Thira, the gleaming white town at the top, or continue to atmospheric Oia for breathtaking views.

SYMI, GREECE

Tucked into a rocky cove, Symi is framed by colorful neoclassical houses with stairs to the upper towns of Ano Symi and Kastro. The Monastery of Archangel Michael with its elaborate bell tower is a major highlight, as are dozens of other churches, chapels and a Dove of Peace war memorial.

KUŞADASI (EPHESUS), TURKEY

This Turkish town is a gateway for Ephesus, renowned in antiquity. The ornate Library of Celsus, the Temple of Artemis (Diana) and the Theater, where Paul addressed the Ephesians, are all connected by shining marble streets.

CANAKKALE (TROY), TURKEY

The Turkish port city played a pivotal role in everything from the Greek myth of the Golden Fleece to the Gallipoli campaign of World War I. It serves as your portal back in time to ancient Troy, setting for the epic Trojan War of Homer's Iliad. Wander the expansive ruins and climb inside a replica of its infamous wooden horse.

KOPER, SLOVENIA

Formerly an island port with Greek, Roman, and Byzantine ties — and once the most influential city in the Venetian Empire — the Golden Age of Kopek can still be found in the cobblestone streets of an Old Town which boasts a wealth of architecture, cultural monuments, and intriguing shops.

HVAR, CROATIA

From the 12th through 18th centuries, Hvar served as the harbor for the Venetian fleet, and fortifications from this time period still exist today. Modern Hvar is a quiet sailing and fishing town with winding streets, a huge piazza, and vineyards and lavender fields on the hillsides.

VIS, CROATIA

Behind this island's scenic outlooks and picturesque harbor, Vis has a fascinating story with secret WWII operations, traditional fishing villages, local vineyards producing "Vuvaga" white wine and "Plavac" red wine, as well as appearances in Hollywood films.

KOTOR, MONTENEGRO

A cluster of medieval towns hug the sinuous shores of the Bay of Kotor. Winding picturesquely between two looming massifs, it is one of Europe's most breathtaking harbors. Together, they comprise a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

ZAKINTHOS, GREECE

Famous for its isolated "Shipwreck Beach," which is accessible only by boat, this seaside is dotted by breathtaking rock arches and other stone formations that appear to float in the water. The harbor town and its Venetian castle offer panoramic views of both the sea and city.

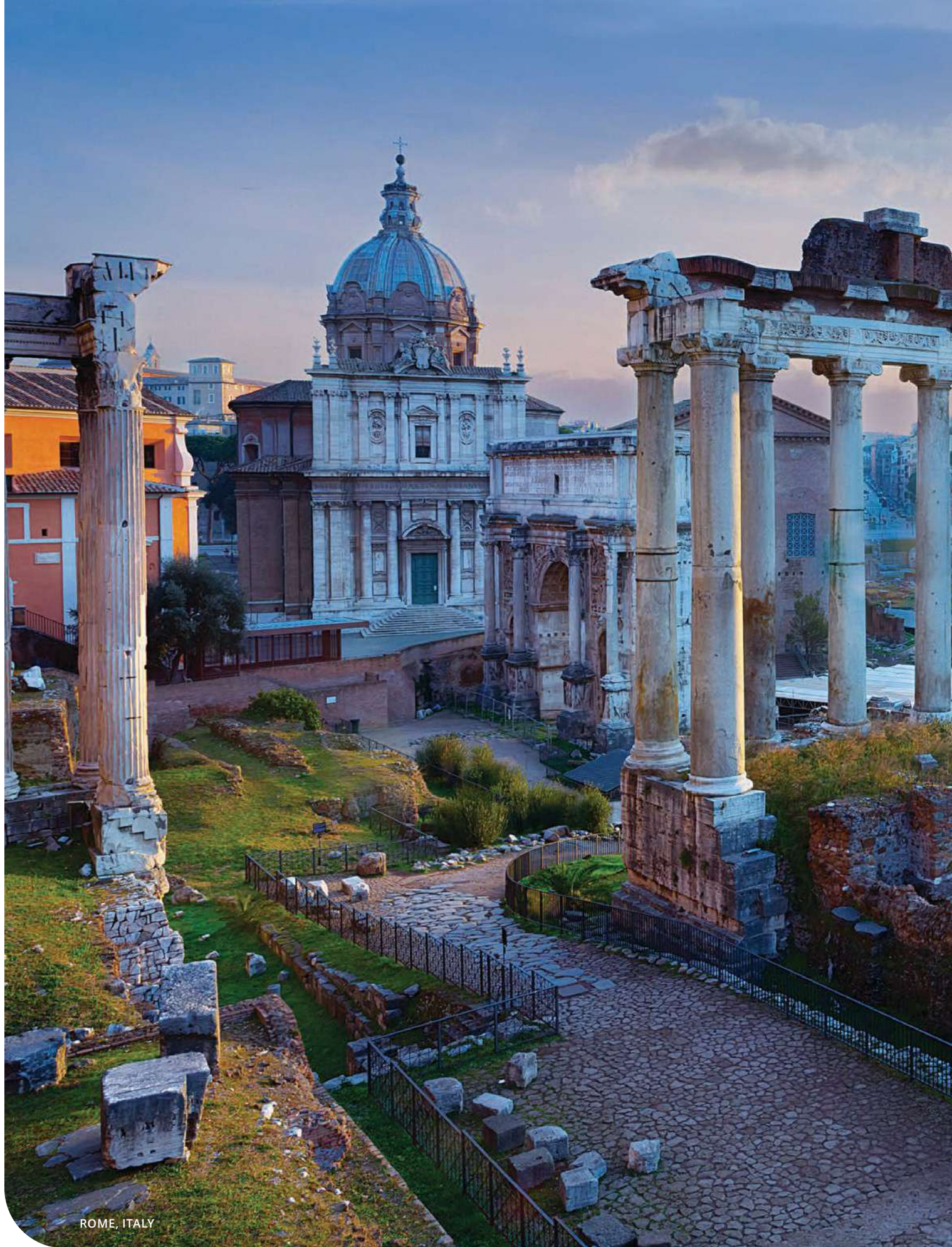

FEATURED PORTS

PALMA DE MALLORCA, SPAIN

Spain's sunny Mediterranean outpost is a pleasant spot boasting a shady plaza near the Gothic Cathedral. Perhaps journey to the enchanting village of Valldemossa, but leave time to shop for false (but lovely) Majorica pearls and handmade lace.

LIMASSOL, CYPRUS

Along with ten miles of meandering shoreline, Limassol features mountain villages, castles and basilicas, ancient archaeological sites dating back to 7,000 BC, vineyards, an upscale marina town with friendly restaurants and chic fashion and jewelry boutiques.

AMALFI, ITALY

One of the two main towns on the famed Amalfi drive, Amalfi is known for its stunning beaches, majestic Duomo di Sant'Andrea cathedral, colorful Majolica tiles, the Chiostro del Paradiso cloister gardens and The Museo della Carta where you can make paper using the traditional medieval methods.

GOLFO ARANCI, SARDINIA, ITALY

The Sardinian coastline is serrated by deep-cut coves of sparkling sea, surrounded by rocky prominences and edged in lovely strands of beach. The Aga Khan fell in love with the place, and dubbed it the Costa Smeralda, creating a magnet for the global glitterati, who adore its silvery white sands.

ST. TROPEZ, FRANCE

The modern glamour never really deserts this town famous for Bardot and a film festival, but the venerable village perché of Grimaud in the nearby Maures Massif has an 11th-century Grimaud Castle with links to Monaco's ruling Grimaldis.







TALLINN, ESTONIA



MÁLAGA (GRANADA), SPAIN

The birthplace of Pablo Picasso, Málaga wine, and a style of flamenco, Málaga is an incredibly interesting glimpse at life in southern Spain through the ages. First settled by the Phoenicians, Málaga has been a capital of many dynasties, as evidenced by two Moorish fortresses still standing today.

LEIXÕES (PORTO), PORTUGAL

The commercial center of northern Portugal and hub of the port wine trade, Porto is a gracious, cosmopolitan city noted for its 12th-century cathedral and medieval churches, picturesque narrow streets, wine lodges at Vila Nova de Gaia and hidden Baroque treasures.

ROUEN (PARIS), FRANCE

Among the most popular cities of outer Paris, Rouen, the “City of a Hundred Spires,” is home to the Cathedrale Notre-Dame, the Gros-Horloge Renaissance clock, the Place du Vieux Marche and enduring medieval ambience.

HAMBURG, GERMANY

Free spirited, artsy and diverse Hamburg is an eclectic city where you can relax in lovely parks one minute, browse an outdoor market the next, take in live theatre or comedy, or stroll red-brick canals all in the same day.

GDAŃSK, POLAND

A monument to strength and perseverance, Gdańsk has wavered between Poland and Germany for centuries. The historic Old City has been rebuilt since World War II and offers a look at the city's past, present and future.

TALLINN, ESTONIA


Ivory stone walls, cobblestone streets, red-roofed towers, windmills and a Gothic Revival Cathedral make Tallinn feel like a gateway into medieval times that's seamlessly blended with modern-day enjoyments.

VISBY, SWEDEN

Often called the City of Roses, the namesake flowers bloom nearly all year, framing 17 medieval churches, the Old Apothecary, museums with Viking rune stones and artifacts, sandy beaches, wild cliffs and rolling pastures.

NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE, ENGLAND, UNITED KINGDOM

Newcastle is a tasteful mix of new and old. Gorgeous newer bridges and the spherical Sage Gateshead Concert Hall stand alongside the traditional Theatre Royal, the Castle Keep, cathedrals and the serene Jesmond Dene Park.



DOUGLAS, ISLE OF MAN, UNITED KINGDOM

A unique self-governing island in the Irish Sea, the Isle of Man is a melting pot of character with stunning natural landscapes, unspoiled beaches, nature reserves, historic churches, diverse museums and nautical exhibits.

BELFAST, NORTHERN IRELAND

Belfast's center is an attractive place with street musicians and a revitalized river front. Visit Titanic Belfast, the star-shaped repository of all things RMS *Titanic*.

HEIMAÆY, ICELAND

The Westman Islands are among Nature's youngest geologic creations. Heimaey's shape and size were drastically changed by a 1973 eruption. Eldheimar is a museum with history of the eruption and an excavated house. The bird cliffs of Heimaey Island are a great place to see puffins, as they nest herein astonishing numbers. Take on optional Zodiac® cruise to the small inner bay near the town and cruise along the cliffs for an up-close view.

REYKJAVÍK, ICELAND

Reykjavík traces its history back to A.D. 870. It was one of the first permanent Norse settlements in Iceland. Colorful rooftops and the elegant spire of Hallgrímskirkja Church are dwarfed by its mountainous backdrop.

VIGUR, ICELAND

Vigur has a great reputation among bird watchers. The harmonious gathering of thousands of birds completes the beautiful landscape – it is a must see. Eider ducks, Arctic terns, puffins, black guillemot and more, make their homes here. QAQORTOQ (JULIANEHÅB), GREENLAND
