



Heritage is our legacy from the past, what we live with today, and what we pass on to future generations. Since its beginnings in 1959, the mission of the World Heritage Centre has been to identify, safeguard and promote unique natural and cultural heritage around the world deemed to possess universal value for all humankind. Today it is an organization of 191 states parties, all united in mutual agreement that such significant importance transcends national location or origin, and ought to be preserved for the benefit of everyone on earth.

The list of inscribed World Heritage properties includes many high-profile historic and archaeological sites such as Venice and its Lagoon, India's Taj Mahal and the temple complex of Borobudur in Indonesia. It also encompasses natural splendors such as Iguazú Falls located between Argentina and Brazil, Australia's Blue Mountains and the exquisite Plitvice Lakes of Croatia. Some sites are designated as possessing mixed natural and cultural significance. The list also contains intangible cultural heritage such as indigenous musical traditions or the remarkable non-verbal "whistling" language that developed on La Gomera in Spain's Canary Islands.

It is only natural that Seabourn's hundreds of destinations include many of the same places that UNESCO has inscribed to their list of World Heritage Sites. Our membership in the UNESCO alliance offers significant advantages for our guests:
